The journey to school wasn't simple for Asmine, but she still managed to push through and graduated from Faustin First High School, in Haiti. Upon graduating from high school, she went on to culinary school, named Maison Menagere, located in Haiti, to pursue her dream of becoming a chef.

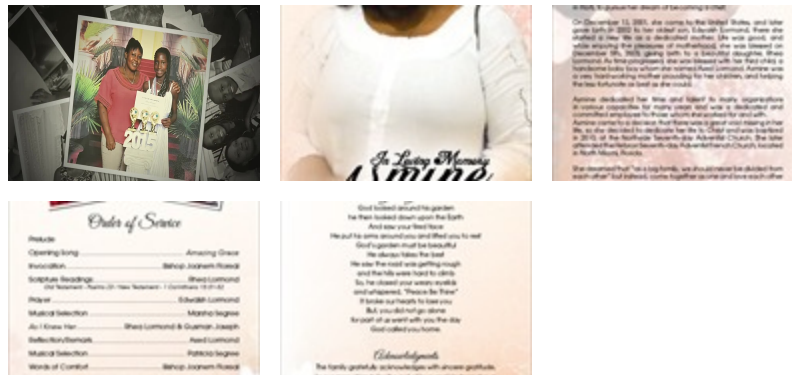
