Denise Demezier, affectionately known as, “Aliette,” was born on May 9, 1963 in Gonaives, Haiti. She was the ninth of thirteen children born to her parents. She was loved by all and was treasured from an early age by family and friends, including her lifelong friends, Suzie Bazar and Chestly Jean-Pierre. Her fondest childhood memories that she loved to share involved her mother and the times they shared together, especially the way her mother taught her about life.

Denise migrated to Mexico, then the United States and lived in Miami, Florida. She eventually became a U.S. citizen and worked hard to become a cosmetologist. As a mother to three children, she worked hard to maintain her family. In addition to being a hairstylist, Denise had also worked in housekeeping and as a chef in her lifetime. These were not just jobs for Denise however, she did what she was truly passionate about. Among these things, she enjoyed doing hair, cooking, babysitting, listening to music, playing soccer when she was much younger, helping others in their times of need, but most importantly, spending time with her children.

On May 14, 2021, Denise Demezier went home to the Lord. She was 58 years old. As a Catholic Christian and a true believer, Denise always trusted in God as her refuge and believed in the words of Psalm 91, that “Whoever dwells in the shelter of the Most-High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.” She is

survived by her eldest daughter, Patricia Limage; her middle daughter, Berlinda Demezier; her only son and last child, Kelly Demezier; her granddaughter, Nakayla Mocombe; her brother, Francois "Doc" Demezier; and many other relatives and friends including her siblings in Haiti.

Denise is remembered as such a comedian who loved to talk to people and make them laugh. Young adults will remember her best as someone who would talk to them about relationships and life. She had such a beautiful heart and was always there to help others. No matter how many "no's" she got, she still kept on going. The love that she had for her children was unconditional and unbreakable. She had such a great soul. Denise wore so many hats effortlessly, from therapist, to comedian, to chef, beautician, and bargain hunter. She shared that her only disappointments in life were not being able to drive on her own, not being able to travel as much with her children, not opening up her own restaurant, and not being able to buy her dream home. Yet, in spite of those disappointments, her life was lived in such a way that she is remembered for her strength, for being a nurturer to so many and nothing less than royalty to everyone who knew her. She will be loved and deeply missed.

The funeral service for Denise Demezier will be held on Saturday May 29, 2021 from 12-1pm at Holy Family Catholic Church. She will be laid to rest immediately after the funeral service at Caballero Rivero Southern Memorial Park. Kelly, Gandy, Lukens, Ralph, Francois, and Sylvester (Bobo) will carry out the solemn honor of being her pallbearers. A reception will follow the burial at St. Fort's Funeral Home at 2pm.
