### OBITUARY

Accepting Christ at an early age, “Grandma” was a member of St. Mary’s Missionary Baptist Church, (Washington Park) where she served on the Mother’s Board and would later become a member of Jesus People Victorious Living Church, under the leadership of Pastor Austin Darling Sr. where she attended faithfully with her granddaughter and evolved into the Prayer Warrior she was.

Know to be loving, caring, and hilarious; “Grandma” was also known to speak

her mind, but often softened her spiciness with an immediate “I LOVE YOU!” after getting her point across! She LOVED her family unconditionally, especially her grandchildren and never missed a family trip nor gathering. Going to church, Praise and Worship, and attending North Dade Adult Day Care was the highlight of her life and brought about immense joy and happiness to her soul. “Grandma”
