The death of an exceptional person leaves a terrible void but also a considerable moral legacy. We are all carriers of this flame that she lit in our hearts. Today it is difficult for me, your child to write this speech. I would like to express my sincere condolences at this time of mourning to all my family, and friends of the deceased and show them all my sympathy and my support.

Filicia Mardy was born in Lamontagne Terre Rouge Jacmel on February 8, 1928, and died on June 7, 2023. Daughter of Petit-sor Sénatus and Bléziné Mardy, she was the 6th in a family of seven children. Mother of seven children, three of whom headed for the father's house.

A loving mother, devoted woman, and hard worker, she gave herself body and soul for the success of her children as well as her grandchildren. She used traditional medicine to help her loved ones in times of need and money was not her priority especially when it came to her family. Humble, generous (li always gen yon ti manje lap sere pou nenpòt moun ki ta vini) never tired when it was business. Each niece, nephew, cousin, each member of the family was like the fruit of his womb. Our world collapsed, and a part of us died. She was our compass, our mentor. Even if everything was going wrong knowing that Filicia Mardy is there, we knew that everything is not over (menm yon te l'ap gentan baw). She always advocated peace and family harmony. We hope that she will guide each of us towards this peace, this love she had for her family.

She left us with a great void, endless pain. Filicia wanted us strong and happy, we will do our best to achieve this even with joyless days and sleepless nights. This June 7, we lost the “mapou” of the family and today we wonder who to trust in our illnesses, and our anxieties in this cruel and uncertain world. We would like to thank everyone who has shown their support during this difficult time.
