



Gerard Marc

September 27, 1932 - March 13, 2025

Pastor Gérard Marc, a beloved and devoted servant of God, entered into eternal rest on Thursday, March 13, 2025, at the age of 92. Born on September 27, 1932, in Cap-Haïtien, Haïti, he was the eldest child of Mr. Ismaël Marc and Mrs. Tatiana Hyppolite-Marc, both of whom preceded him in death. He was also predeceased by his sister, Nanoune Marc-Saintilma. Pastor Gérard completed his education at Lycée Philippe Guerrier in Cap-Haïtien before moving to Port-au-Prince, Haïti. Early in his career, he pursued formal training in automotive technology, becoming a certified auto mechanic technician. However, his true calling lay in serving God and ministering to others.

In 1953, he met the love of his life, the late Anne-Marie Ferdinand- Marc, while both were members of the renowned prayer group “La Grande Cohorte” in Port-au-Prince. They were married on December 17, 1955, and their love blossomed into a marriage that lasted 53 golden years. Their union was blessed with five children, 16 grandchildren, 22 great-grandchildren, and one great-great- grandchild. They shared a devoted life together until his beloved wife, Anne-Marie, passed away on January 8, 2009.

In 1967, Pastor Gérard Marc took a leap of faith and moved to America for a better life with his wife and three children, relocating his family to Miami, Florida, where his youngest son, Gary Marc was born.

Pastor Gérard pursued theological studies at New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary, graduated in 1984, equipping himself with the knowledge and

spiritual depth necessary for his ministry. Pastor Gérard was a man of unwavering faith, a compassionate leader, and a devoted servant of God who placed others before himself. Throughout his life, he dedicated himself to preaching the Word of God, and advancing His kingdom through humility, integrity, and unwavering devotion. He was a beacon of faith, consistently touching and impacting lives through his ministry.

He had a deep and abiding love for God's people. The church community embraced him in his faith and commitment to God's work, offering steadfast love and support for over 40 years in pastoral service. His legacy will endure through the countless lives he touched, the seeds of faith he planted, and the wisdom and grace with which he led. He served as an assistant pastor at benezer Baptist Church and later moved to "Église Dieu-Vivant", and served as pastor alongside Sr. Fernande Constant.

Following the passing of his beloved wife Anne-Marie, Pastor Gérard later married Semerite Louis-Marc, who survives him.
