



Germaine Torchon

June 28, 1937 - August 12, 2025

Germaine Torchon, affectionately known by many as NinNin, was called home to be with the Lord on August 12, 2025, at 11:30 p.m., at the age of 88.

Born on June 28, 1937, in Miragoâne, Haiti, in a small village called Bel Otes, Germaine was the firstborn child of Mrs. Emiliene Thomas and Mr. Philip Torchon. She was the eldest of four children: her late brother Raymond, her devoted brother Osnel who cared for her throughout her illness, and her sister Iderle Torchon.

At an early age, the family relocated from Miragoâne to Port-au-Prince, where Germaine completed her primary and secondary education. In 1972, she graduated from the Elegantissima School of High Dressmaking, beginning a career that allowed her to serve her community with skill and dedication.

In 1992, Germaine began traveling between Haiti and the United States, and in 1996 she decided to settle permanently in the U.S. to better support her family. Though she never married and had no biological children, she embraced her role as a caregiver and mentor, extending her love to family, friends, and especially to her adoptive daughter, Sofia Thomas.

Germaine was a woman of deep faith and devotion to God. She was a dedicated choir member at La Sainte Famille Notre Dame Church and was admired for her unwavering courage and strength. Despite her own struggles and suffering, she never lost faith, often encouraging others— even those in far better circumstances than her own. Her resilience and her legendary courage inspired all who knew her.

Germaine's life was a true testimony of service, sacrifice, and faith. She will be remembered for her kindness, her strength, her laughter, and her unshakable trust in God.

She leaves to cherish her memory: her brother Osnel, her sister Iderle Torchon, her adoptive daughter Sofia Thomas; her nephews and nieces Jimmy Valmont, Claire Valmont St. Georges, Sonson Torchon, Zico Torchon, Eder Torchon, Sherly Torchon, Edwidge Torchon, Maggie, Johnny, Robinson, and Steven Torchon; as well as many extended family members, friends, and her church family.

Though nature took its course and God has called her home, her faith, courage, and legacy will continue to live on in the hearts of all who loved her. May her soul rest in eternal peace.
