On Thursday, November 18, 2021, we were privileged but sad to see Lascells Walcut Reid transition to the greatest of freedom and peace with his last breath on earth.

This dynamic man went to his true home at age 76, and humanity was left so much darker with his departure. Husband, Father, Grandfather, Son, Brother, Confidante and friend all with heart, hope, and care he embraced.

On March 28, 1945, Las was born in Tweedside, Clarendon, Jamaica, W.I to Martin Reid and Pearlina Morris. He married his wife of almost 51 years, Violet "Blossom" Reid, on December 12, 1971.

Las attended The Mico Teachers' College. Following his graduation, he taught at Altson Secondary School and Haile Selassie Secondary School as a math teacher. He eventually became head of the Mathematics Department. He subsequently transitioned to insurance, where he worked as a representative at Life of Jamaica for several years. Following his migration to Miami, Florida with his family, he continued his career path with Orkin, until he retired. Las'

lifelong family and numerous friendships are really testimonies of how precious he was, and how he lived his life, with connections from Jamaica to the United States, Canada and England. We may never know how many lives he has touched throughout the span of his life.
