



## Marie Anne Simone Bayol

November 1, 1931 - September 13, 2021

Marie Anne Simone was born in Léogâne, Haiti on November 1st, 1931. She was the 2nd child of Lahens Dessaint and Estérilia Joseph. She dedicated her whole life to her family and her profession. As a teacher, she inspired thousands of students and was highly respected by her colleagues. She never gave up to any minor or major difficulties in her life even during her retirement. She was 89 years old when she departed this life on Monday, September 13, 2021, after a short stay at the hospital. She has now joined her late husband, Gérard Philanthrope Bayol, her beloved mom Estérilia, and her sister Eva. She leaves to cherish her memory her four daughters Marie Yolene B. Saintclair, Marie Jose Bayol, Marie Carline B. Mervil, and Marie Gessy B. Suffy as well as her only son Jean Gérard Bayol.
