Ofnide was a supportive, loving, non-judgmental, and honest person who embraced everyone that crossed her path. At the age of fourteen, Ofnide accepted Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior. She walked a steady path in pursuit of Jesus. She volunteered with the children's ministry, the church cleanup crew, and worked as the church secretary for multiple years at Community Christian Church.
