Pelisier Costume “AKA” Gerson, age 78, passed away on Saturday morning, May 25, 2024, at Memorial Regional Hospital in Hollywood, FL.

Gerson was born on December 8th, 1945, in Garde 6eme, 8eme Section of L’Attalaye in St Michel, Haiti to Marie Rose Fircil, and Mr Alexis Isaac.

He was partly raised by his aunt Matilde Fircil “dit” Grann Cemathe. He attended primary school in St Michel and later on, married Miss Anne Marie Chervilus “AKA” Solange Costume.
