Peter always had an outgoing personality. From NMB to North Miami, he was well-known

everywhere he went, and everyone loved him. When he was younger, he was a good football

player for North Miami Beach Sundevils. He was such a good running back that they nicknamed

him Psycho. After practice or after a game, our parents would drop him off at Dada's house.

There Dada would feed him, tell him to clean up, and he'd go back outside to throw the football

around with the neighborhood kids.

Whether it was at Dada's house, our house, our family's house, Peter grew up around a lot of

people. Even then, Peter always did his own thing. As he grew older, he began to have

difficulties that he had little control over. This crushed our immediate family.

He was still a handsome young man. But the brother we grew up with, who would prank us, and who was so full-of-life, was battling demons.

Occasionally, we questioned God about why he was going through this battle.

Knowing we shouldn't question God, ultimately... we just wanted God to deliver him. We didn't know it would come this way. But we know he's free now and that reality makes it easier to accept that he's gone.

Peter left behind his mother, Andromaque Joseph; his older brother, Kaven St. Louis; and his

older sisters, Kimberly St. Louis and Natacha St. Louis; and younger brother, Jonel St. Louis. He

also left behind his beautiful nieces, and adorable nephews.
