



## Rose Marie Clergeau

September 8, 1952 - November 11, 2022

Rosemarie Clergeau was born on September 8, 1952, in Archaie, Haiti. She was the sixth child born to her parents, Marius René and Josina Dufrenne. She was loved by all and was treasured from an early age by family and friends, including her siblings, Polonne, Rigaud, Pierre Andre, and Edecia René; as well as her lifelong friends Nanan, Yanick, Geenie, and Mikaelle. Rosemarie was educated in Haiti where she attended prescolaire-Ecole Mm Benicia, primaire- Congraniste Saint Francois de Salles, Lucias Salomon, and secondaire- Lycée Francois Duvalier. She eventually migrated to the United States, settling in Boston, MA, Providence, R.I., and Miami, FL. Rosemarie married the love of her life, Pastor Maccenne Clergeau and together they built a life that extended to their children, their faith, and their community. She lived a life of service as a schoolteacher and as the 1st Lady of Christian Assembly Church of Haiti.

On November 11, 2022, in Archaie, Haiti, Rosemarie Clergeau went home to the Lord. She was 70 years old. As a Christian and a true believer, Rosemarie always trusted in God as her refuge and believed in the words of Psalm 91, that "Whoever dwells in the shelter of the Most-High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty." She is survived by her husband, Jean Maccenne Clergeau; her son, Edson Clergeau; her daughters, Rose and Emmanuella Clergeau; and her grandsons, Elijah, Isaiah, and Eisa Clergeau.
