



Sidoles Escarmant

December 28, 1948 - November 6, 2024

Sidoles Escarmant was born in St. Louis Du Nord, Haiti on December 28, 1948. He was the fourth of Samson and Anne Desilia Escarmant's twelve children (both deceased). He spent most of his early childhood in St. Louis Du Nord. His education started in primary school at St. Julien Gabriel and secondary school at Dantes Bellegard College. With the financial assistance of his eldest brother Julson, he immigrated to the Bahamas to finish his education at the age of 19. Before leaving, he promised his soon to be wife Marie Rose Brave that he would return to Haiti to marry her. In 1966, he arrived to Freeport, Bahamas and joined his brothers Julson and Gaston. He started working as a bartender. Four years later, Sidoles finally saved enough money and returned to Haiti to marry his Marie.

On April 4th, 1970, Sidoles and Marie were married in St. Louis Du Nord. He subsequently returned to the Bahamas to continue working to save enough money for his wife to join him in the Bahamas. Throughout the 70s he continued to travel back and forth between Haiti and the Bahamas. During that time, he started his family and welcomed four daughters. In 1975, Sidoles left the Bahamas for the United States for a better life for his growing family. In 1976, his wife Marie move to America (Miami, Florida) to join him and together they increased their family size by four. They welcomed three more daughters and finally a son who is the youngest in 1983. While building his family, he worked as a chef, but his passion was always bartending. He worked as a bartender at Tropicala Night Club for over two decades until he retired.

In October 2018, Sidoles suffered a massive stroke. He spent several weeks in the hospital and a rehabilitation center in hopes of making a full recovery. To the surprise of medical professionals, he made great progress while in rehabilitation.

Although we wish things could have been different, the Lord called him home at 4:44 am on November 6, 2024, leaving his wife Marie Rose, seven children: Kelaine, Rodnie, Ketly (Enel Rosier), Pitchie (Michael), Tasha, Millie, and Sidney Escarmant; his grandchildren: Christian J.
