Solange Joseph was born on December 16, 1941, to Abraham Joseph and Gertrude Louis Joseph in Bassin-Bleu, Port-de-Paix, Haiti. Solange was the fifth of seven children born to Abraham and Gertrude. At a very early age, she took on the role of caretaker for her siblings supporting her parents to provide for the family. Even as a young child, Solange had the vision to one day leave Haiti and make a way for her siblings to do so as well for a better life.

In 1973, Solange began traveling to different islands in the Caribbean before settling in Guadeloupe. Solange had a very lucrative career in commerce and trade that allowed her to do the two things she loved best; she loved to travel and to provide for her family. In 1984, Solange moved to Jersey City, NJ in the United States. In Jersey City, she attended Eglise de Dieu led by Pastor Lazarre. Under the direction and teaching of Pastor Lazarre, the support of her beloved church and by the move of the Holy Spirit, Solange was baptized in 1986, giving her life to Christ.
